95% attendance (poor attendance!)

What happens next?

After the Exam (Up to January Results)

Pupils continue to study maths covering topics in more depth and preparing them for future study.

What happens next (after the results)

a) If pupils achieve a C grade; Use Maths lessons to work towards sitting the Higher Tier in the Summer

b) If pupils achieve a C grade and require additional English support; Split lessons between Maths and English

c) Pupils who do not achieve a C grade will continue to work on the Maths Foundation Tier Paper
