### **Standing Orders and Gift Aid**

Not everyone can give time to help the school, but would like to make a commitment of support.

This can easily be achieved through establishing a regular Standing Order donation through your bank account - either monthly, or annually.

If you are a UK Tax payer and tick the Gift Aid Box on the form then we can claim back an additional 25p for every pound you donate—so a donation of £1 per month

which has been gift aided is increased to £1.25 per month (£15 per year) courtesy of the Tax Man. With over 1600 students, a £1 donation on behalf of each of them would equate to a massive £24.000 a year and it couldn't be easier-just complete the form on the opposite page, and return to the school and we will do the rest. If you do experience problems or would like to set up your Standing Order via Internet Banking, please fill in the top
