## Message from the Chair

Hello again and welcome to the first Newsletter of the 2016/17 Academic Year.

Firstly I want to thank all parents who have given their time and hard earned cash to support this wonderful school and update you all on the benefits this has brought to your children.

As you know our big drive last year was to secure a grant from the Wolfson Foundation to help us upgrade our Science Laboratories, as part of this we as a PTA made a commitment to raise funds to help. The wonderful news is that at the end of last Term Wolfson Foundation let us know that we had been successful in securing a grant from them of £35,000! This, together with funds from the School and the money we raised last year as a PTA (£15,000) has enabled the school to begin work over the

October half term on updating the rooms which have not been touched since the 1960s. The first job was replacing the corrugated ceilings with new suspended ceilings and brighter lights, making a massive difference to the environment for the students and staff alike. We will keep you updated on progress in future newsletters.

In addition to this we were able to help the Music Department replace outdated IT technology by replacing their equipment at the end of the July, giving them a boost for the new year in September.

The car boot sales are going from strength to strength and have become a regular event every month with a strong regular following. The last boot sale on Sunday 13 November earned the PTA nearly £400 and they will begin again after the Winter

Break in February next year.

It has been wonderful meeting new Year 7 Parents and many of them have already committed to the PTA by attending meetings and coming along to help - thank you!.

A new event especially for the new Year 7 families will be a Festive Cinema Night for the students on 1 December, giving their parents a chance to get to know each other over a cup of tea and a mince pie in the hall - please come along if you get the opportunity it would be lovely to meet you.

Finally don't forget our Christmas Craft Fayre on Sunday 27th November from 2 – 5 pm, an ideal opportunity to meet local crafters and buy those unique Christmas presents or cards.


