Sixth Form Uniform Policy

It has come to our attention that many students are wearing non-uniform tops in the sixth form at present. I have printed the sixth form dress code overleaf as a reminder for what is not acceptable to for students to wear. Any non-uniform items that are continued to be worn after Easter holidays will be confiscated.

In consideration of previous requests it was agreed that tailored black shorts, with the school badge, will be added to the summer uniform for both boys and girls, these can only be purchased from YC Sports, no other shorts will be permitted and students will be sent home to change.

At present, there are a minority of students who are wearing facial piercings these are not permitted in the sixth form and should be removed for school.

All students must adhere to this dress code throughout examinations.

In key stage 5 students are subject to a dress/appearance code and are required to wear "top half" Cardiff High endorsed garments in order to both identify them as members of our school and also to promote a sense of identity and belonging amongst our upper school students.

"Bottom Half Garments"

Students are permitted wear any suitable "bottom half" garments eg trousers/jeans/skirt

Non Uniform shorts or cut-off trousers are NOT permitted

"Top Half Garments"

Students can then select from a variety of different coloured Cardiff High endorsed "top half" garments showing the school badge. Eg T-shirts, Polo shirts, sweatshirts or hoodies. Students are permitted to wear garments purchased to indicate a membership of a team, society or trip as long as the Cardiff High badge is clearly visible. Students are not permitted to wear any top half garments which do not display the school badge.

It is important that Upper School students set an example and are suitably attired at all times.

Unsuitable Dress

- **Non Uniform Shorts**
- **Cut-off trousers**
- **Ripped/torn clothing**
- **Short skirts**
- **Hats/hoods worn inside**
- **Large earrings/excessive jewellery**
- **High heels/flip flops**
- **No facial piercings**

The final arbiters of what is considered to be suitable dress are the Head of School and the Key Stage 5 Achievement Leaders. Entering the Upper School indicates a willingness to comply with the above requirements and students who fail to observe the standards outlined above will be sent to change or supplied with alternative clothing.

Hair

- **Tramlines or patterns cut into the hair or eyebrows are not permitted.**
- **Inappropriate coloured hair or streaks in the hair are not permitted.**
- **Pupils will be sent home if they have a hairstyle that the Headteacher feels inappropriate for school.**
