Dear Parent/Carer

I hope your child has had a good first couple of weeks of the academic year. I am writing to update you about some assessments that all pupils in year 7 will be taking this half term.

Personalised assessments in reading and numeracy are taken by all learners in years 2 to 9 each year in all maintained schools in Wales. I am sure you will be familiar with these from primary school; they provide feedback on students' reading and numeracy skills so that students, their teachers and their parents/carers can understand where they are in their learning journey.

Pupils in Year 7 will be completing these assessments in the week beginning Monday 29<sup>th</sup> September. They will access them online via Hwb on school chromebooks during normal maths and English lessons, having had an opportunity to practise sample questions in advance. There is nothing additional that students need to do outside of their maths and English lessons to prepare for these assessments.

We appreciate that any mention of 'assessment' can cause some anxiety but want to reassure you that these are designed to provide information and move learning forward. These assessments will give a snapshot of student understanding and progress in key topics and skills, helping teachers to see what students can do and what areas they may need to work on as we progress through the academic year. Teachers will use this information to support your child's progress by planning for their next steps in learning.

Feedback from these assessments will be available to you on the students Hwb account the day after they sit them in school.
