



E-Learning Code of Conduct



Dear Parent/Carer

As part of our curriculum we encourage students to make use of educational resources available on the Internet. Access to the Internet enables students to conduct research and obtain high quality educational resources from libraries, museums, galleries and other information sources from around the world.

We also provide students with access to an online Learning Platform via a unique username and password. This Learning Platform allows users to communicate via e-mail, store their work remotely and gives them access to online learning resources which are all available anytime and anywhere there is an internet connection. Accounts are regularly monitored and any inappropriate material that may be illegal, defamatory, and inaccurate or potentially offensive to some people will be removed and the account holder may be subjected to the school's disciplinary policy.

Our aim for the Learning Platform is to support educational goals and objectives and to facilitate independent learning skills and communication across the school.

To guard against accidental access to materials which are inappropriate in school all Cardiff schools access the Internet and the Learning Platform by means of the Cardiff Council Network which provides a 100% assurance that students might not accidentally come across material which would be inappropriate. We believe that the educational benefits to students from access to the Internet and the Learning Platform, in the form of information resources and opportunities for collaborations, far outweigh the potential disadvantages.

Therefore, before they access the Internet and Learning Platform we would like all students to discuss the attached E-Learning Code of Conduct with their parents/carers and sign the form and return with the yellow registration forms.
