Dear Parent/Carer,

Thank you for your positive comments regarding the weekly update letters. This will be the last one for the term. We will, however, write to you towards the end of the holiday regarding any updates related to the return to school.

Covid-19 Update

Whilst the decision to send pupils home following a positive diagnosis is never easy, we have been very pleased with the high level of engagement with our home learning timetables. Thank you for supporting this process and for your e mails expressing gratitude for the quality of the provision and the hard work undertaken by staff. These messages have been shared with colleagues.

You will be probably be aware that Welsh Government has made the decision to reduce the coronavirus self-isolation and quarantine period from 14 days to 10 days. This means that individuals identified as a close contact of someone who has tested positive will have to self-isolate for 10 days and not 14. The self-isolation period will be the same, therefore, for those who are identified as contacts and those who have tested positive for the virus. Please be advised that as of December 10, we shall be applying the 10 day rule within our school based track and trace protocols.

Once we have been notified of a positive case, the school undertakes a rigorous track and trace exercise. Following this, families of close contacts are notified of the child's need to isolate via the Parent Pay system. If you have not already signed up for Parent Pay, please can we encourage you to do so. This will ensure that you receive any vital information as speedily as possible. The system also allows for the sending of texts to families which is very

useful, particularly if we need to send pupils home within a school day. For any queries regarding this, please contact Mrs Sarah Young on YoungS11@hwbcymru.net.

We have been pleased, on the whole, with the way in which our pupils have responded to the wearing of face coverings this term. Please may we request that your child remembers to bring at least one each day. Each pupil has now received four washable masks from the Local Authority. Should they forget, they may purchase one from reception at the subsidised price of £1.

Parent Pay Accounts

Please may we politely request that you check that your child's Parent Pay account has sufficient funds for next term. We will continue to offer our full break and lunch time provision following the Christmas break.

If your child is in receipt of free school meals and is required, by the school, to self-isolate at any point next term, the Local Authority will send supermarket vouchers to your home address.


Sixth Form Application Process
