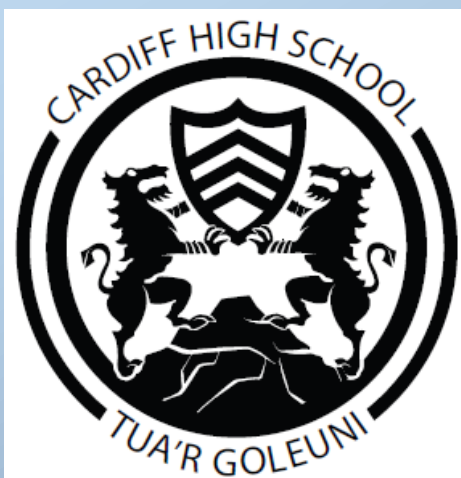

It is aimed at effective teachers, with a number of years of classroom experience, who have the potential to become consistently outstanding and have a mind-set of growth and pursuit of excellence. The OTP also covers the acclaimed “power of coaching” module which will introduce practitioners to the use of coaching in school settings.

- Develop a higher level of understanding of teaching approaches and will improve the classroom learning experience for their classes
- Develop the ability to coach colleagues and pupils, both formally and informally, in their own school to grow others and raise standards
- Develop the ability to effectively lead and support a school culture where the quality of teaching and learning is openly observed, discussed, reflected upon and enhanced

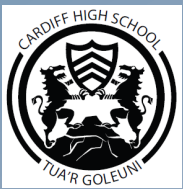

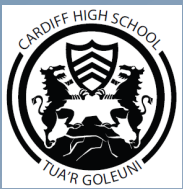

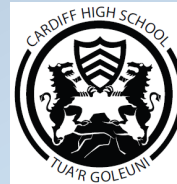
