Being Prepared for the Exam

- Exam timetables – all have been issued – know the date and start time of each exam – a presentation on how to read the exam timetable is on the Google Classroom along with a blank exam overview planning sheet
- New timetables will be issued this week (tomorrow Yr13; Friday Yr12) with venue and seat allocations
- The date and time of the examination **WILL NOT CHANGE**. If the exam is missed, students **WILL NOT** be credited marks for it
- Please be aware the contingency day allocated in the WJEC Examination timetable is **NOT** a day for individual students to catch up on a missed exam
- If there is a clash of examinations, students will have already been notified. Their new exam timetable will inform them of where and when the exam will be sat – packed lunch/ snacks needed on these days

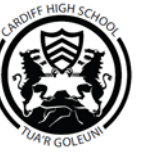


Be Prepared: Start Times



- Be at the venue at least 15 minutes before the published exam time
- Morning exams start **promptly** at 09.00 – arrive at venue for **08.45** at the very latest
- Afternoon exams start **promptly** at 13.30 – arrive at venue for **13.15** at the very latest





Be Prepared: Venues

- Students will have an individual timetable with venue and seat numbers for each exam
- Venues will be posted each morning in the following locations:
 - Ty Celyn
 - Sports Hall
 - Learning Hub



Illness

If a student is ill on the day of the exam, they will still need to attend the examination.



Exam Protocol Reminders



- School uniform **MUST** be worn to each exam
- Students will be issued with an **ID card** with their timetable. This **MUST** be brought to each exam with you and placed on the desk
- Mobile phones
- No wrist watches are allowed into the venue
- No food allowed in the exam hall
- Water only with label removed



Equipment

- Check the equipment required for each exam
- Check calculators, etc. are working. Calculators for Maths, Physics and Chemistry must be in examination mode and the students must be able to do this themselves before entering the exam hall. A video on how to do this is on the Google Classroom or they can speak to their teachers
- Write in **BLACK INK** only – bring spare pens
- Clear pencil cases only
